Nope, not Bill Clinton. However, like the new President-Elect, I would like to thank you for giving me the opportunity to serve as your President in 1993.

I know that you will join me in taking this opportunity to thank our out-going President Dave Vanderwall, KD4SV, for his great efforts on our behalf in 1992. I hope that I can come close to doing the same type of good job during my term as President.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank Hal Myers, K4JHM, for all of his contributions to the club over the past several years serving in his capacity as club Secretary. Hal has done an excellent job in keeping track of the expanding membership of the M.F.A.R.L. and documenting each of our meetings. We will miss having Hal give his monthly reports. Steve Knittel, KC4Y80, will be taking on the duties of Secretary, and he will have some big shoes to fill.

I am very fortunate to have KD4APK, David Fellows, remain on as Vice President, and Fred Moore, N4CLA, remain on as Treasurer and head of the Technical Committee. They have served the club well in the past year, and I look forward to them helping me meet the challenges of the coming year.

The new year should be an exciting one for all of us. Some hot topics already on the 1993 club agenda are:

- 1) club incorporation,
- 2) installation of remote receivers for the .47 repeater,
- 3) effectively dealing with the continued growth of our membership.

As you know, the club has grown significantly in the past two years. When I joined the M.F.A.R.L. in 1991, we were meeting in the Sonny's Bar-B-Q. Now it is not uncommon to see 50 - 75 people join us for dinner and a program at the Cherokee Cattle Company. Because of this growth, I believe that we should seriously consider club incorporation. This is not an overly difficult process. Many amateur clubs have incorporated both in this area, and nationwide. Incorporation does not mean that the M.F.A.R.L. will become any less friendly. But, it should help us in meeting some of our goals, such as seeking 5013C status later on.

On another note, we have been talking about putting up a number of remote receivers for the .47 repeater for some time. Now that the amplifier and filter have been installed on Sweet Mountain, the club can look towards improving the "ears" of the repeater. Fred and I have talked about some of his plans to improve our machine's coverage. How much we will be able to do will depend on your support, and the cost of each project. I will be asking

Fred, in the next couple of months, to present a plan at a monthly meeting for remote receiver installations along with a cost projection for each site. Hopefully, within the next two years, the reception and transmission coverage of our repeater will effectively include most, if not all, of North Georgia.

The growth of the N.F.A.R.L. is also an item of consideration. As the club continues to grow, the demands on the effective use of the club resources will also increase. Each member will expect the best from our facilities and what the club can offer them. Field day, meetings, family social events, programs, repeaters, and auto-patch capabilities, just to name a few, will be high on everyone's lists. Providing the same high level of club involvement within the Amateur community will also take the effort of each member of the N.F.A.R.L. Some will give more than others, but it has been my experience that all club members give of themselves when asked, and when they can.

Along these lines, I am asking for your help in making this a truly great year. If you have any suggestions for monthly programs, please pass your suggestions on to me, or my wife Michelle, WA4WSP. Avery, WB4RTP, as already provided me with one excellent suggestion. I have contacted the Georgia Chapter of the American Red Cross to get a representative to give the club a presentation on their Disaster Action Team program. Hopefully, this will be our January or February program. Other submitted ideas for meetings include:

- 1) another auction (a favorite of this past year),
- 2) a program on Emergency coordination,
- 3) a presentation by members of A/D Technology on the operation of our repeater controller,
- 4) a presentation on packet radio, and
- 5) a meeting where test equipment will be set up to help you check out your radio equipment.

I have some other ideas in the works, but I really need more of your suggestions to help insure that the club gets the best program possible each month during 1993. You can reach me on the nets each Monday night or at 740-7939.

Again, let me thank you for the opportunity to serve the club in 1993, and I hope that it will be a great year for all of us.

See you at the Christmas party on December 9, and have a happy, safe, holiday season.

Jeff Weinberg AA4ARC spoke about the great job Dave Vanderwall has done, it appears that he may be transferring back up to the cold North.

Dave Fellows WD4APK moved that we present a plaque to Dave Vanderwall in appreciation. The motion was seconded and carried.

Fred Moore N4CLA moved that we present a plaque to Bill Driscoll in appreciation for his providing the repeater site which we use. The motion was seconded and carried.

Dave Fellows noted that Danny Turner WA4BRO provides a BBS primarily for the use of WFARL and that this has been a substantial financial burden on Danny. Dave moved that we purchase a 170 MB hard drive for Danny at a cost of \$310. The motion was seconded and carried.

Steve Knittel KC4Y80 reported that we had a very successful field day, being listed in QST as 55 out of 94 stations in our category. The next field day will be 6/26/93 so mark it on your calendar. He also thanked those who brought food.

Dave Fellows reported that we had a negative cash flow of about \$300 this year. This was in part due to the purchase of \$1300 new equipment for the repeater. Dave questioned if the club should be considering a dues increase. Alan Stern N4QHX feels that the club should be working toward owning both repeaters.

William Witt WB6DYD moved that we raise the Standard Member dues by \$5.00 to \$35.00 per year. The motion died for lack of a second. Doug Reed N3AIA moved that we form a budget study group to report back at the next meeting. Motion seconded and carried.

David Mayer KD4ILA moved that we form a committee to find out how much we can get back from the ARRL if we are an affiliated club.

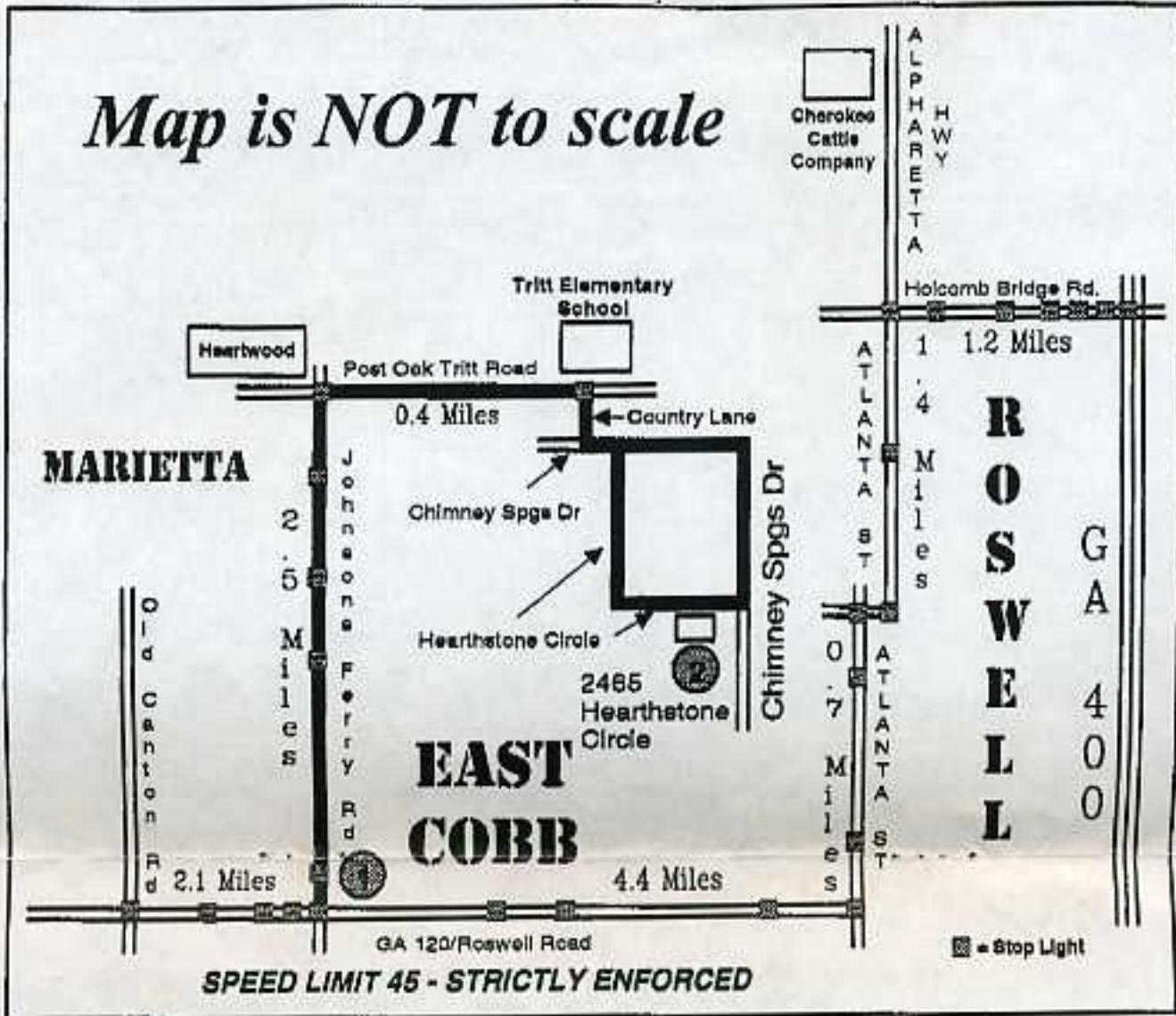

From Johnsons Ferry Road and GA 120 (1) to the Chimney Springs Club House (2):

Go NORTH on **Johnsons Ferry Road** from GA 120. Go 2.5 miles (5 traffic lights) to the intersection where **Heartwood** is on the adjacent corner. Turn RIGHT at the light, this will be **Post Oak Tritt Road**. Go 0.4 miles and turn RIGHT at the flashing light. (You will see Tritt Elementary School and their playground on your left.) The street you are turning on to is **Country Lane**. In one block, Country Lane will dead-end into **Chimney Springs Drive**. Turn LEFT on Chimney Springs Drive. Go one block to the first Stop sign.
