It uses the repeater, Google, a chat room, and now **Echolink** to enhance the quality of this unique net. Go to the website and look under ACTIVITIES/NETS and you'll find the link to the CHAT room. Some great links are posted each week as participants search for answers on the web and listen to experienced members explain things on the repeater.

Repeater News - Echolink is here! The 145.47 repeater now has Echolink. This allows you to connect to the repeater when you are out of town VIA THE INTERNET! This is just one of the capabilities. It also allows the repeater to be connected to other repeaters for general chatting or during emergencies to link repeaters all over the world. NFARL Repeaters and PL-Please be aware that 145.47, 147.06, and 444.475 are ALL now requiring that "YOU" turn on "YOUR" PL encoder to 100Hz in "YOUR" radio to make the repeaters work. Without this tone being set and turned on, you may think the repeaters are NOT working. We have been advertising that we were going to start using PL. It has been in all the news letters for quite some time

Running PL on the repeaters is becoming a standard through out the USA. This is not just being done here in the Metro Atlanta area or just on the NFARL repeaters. NFARL has resisted using PL for at least 2 decades, because we didn't want to keep travelers passing through the area to be locked out of the repeaters or club members that didn't have this capability. However the time has basically come, where we now need to start running PL on all of our repeaters.

If you will turn your PL encoders on and keep them turned on in a memorized channel for these three repeaters, it will not be necessary for you to know whether the repeater is expecting PL or not. It will just always work.

If you need help in figuring out what and how to set your radio, you may call me or send me an email, and I will help you the best I can or find someone that can help you. Please read your manual that came with your radio first. Most every radio today has the capability to use <code>PL(Motorola Private Line) / CTCSS (Continuous Tone-Coded Squelch System) / CG (General Electric Channel Guard).These are all the SAME thing.</code>

Hungry Hams Lunch Bunch each Wednesday @11:45 till? -. In the last 3 lunches, we have had 16, 17, and 16 respectively. Remember, when you go through the line, be sure to ask them to print a receipt and include it in the Radio Club stack. It helps the cause.
